Extract from a report to the recent Church Council EXPLORERS - "You may have noticed that there have been rather more all-age worship services recently. This is because we do not have sufficient staff to run the group/groups. So, while we have a good number of young people, we do not have those of an age to help run Explorers. Poor health, age and other commitments mean that the three regular leaders cannot always be on duty; so, we are facing desperate times if we want to continue our children/young people's work.

We have already appealed on a number of occasions for support from members of the congregation to come

support from members of the congregation to come forward and offer their services. **Unfortunately, this has not met with any success.**

We have reached a critical point and, in all probability, we will have to close Explorers on a Sunday morning unless we get some more volunteers or we think of another way to do Explorers. Even then we would need helpers. If you have any ideas or would like to spend one Sunday with Explorers to see what goes on and gauge if you could join the team, please speak to David, Mary or Hazel. The more helpers we have, the less often you would be on the rota.

Please think and pray about the situation. It would be tragic if we had to close Explorers." Hazel Davis
