Vicki has started the process of learning how to set the heating (4 programmers with 7 zones plus water heating) and will in future need to know of ALL building uses. So, if you organise an event/group please will you ensure that all bookings are put into our 'iknow church diary' and that Vicki knows of any changes needed. This is especially important at school holidays etc when some groups may not meet for a week or so.

It is by regulating the heating to the times needed that we keep unnecessary expenditure and energy use to a minimum, so we need your co-operation with this please. Thank you
